The Mayor and Town Council had the foresight to enact a parking code, and the department of public works and the police department are presently analyzing all residential zones to assist a future resolution designating residential parking only. In addition, the town is now reviewing the permitting procedure and scrutinizing any rental units, Airbnb, or similar types of businesses that are operating within the town.
