WHEREAS, the Town will have to pay a deductible of \$250 to have the damages repaired through the Town's insurance company LGIT; and

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Forest Heights hereby authorize the Mayor or the Town Administrator to sign the contract on behalf of the Town Council, a contract with Vision Auto Body Repair (Exhibit A) not to exceed \$1,953.51; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
