A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO EXPEND FUNDS FOR THE
SENIOR LUNCHEON

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council passed Resolution 33-15 on June 18, 2015 approving the Fiscal Year 2016 Budget for The Town of Forest Heights (the “Town”); and

WHEREAS, Section 33-46 of the Town Charter requires that no public money may be expended without having been appropriated by the Council; and

WHEREAS, each year the Mayor invites all senior citizens of the Town of Forest Heights to participate in an annual senior luncheon; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Council authorizes the Mayor to expend funds for the senior luncheon not to exceed \$2,000; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that said expenditure shall not exceed a sum of \$2,000 and shall be appropriated from Line Item #8028 (Plus 60 Senior Programs) of the Fiscal Year 2016 Town Budget.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
