RESOLUTION 61-17**

**A RESOLUTION TO TRANSFER EQUIPMENT FROM THE DEPUTY CHIEF'S
POLICE VEHICLE TO THE NEW POLICE VEHICLE**

WHEREAS, the Town has purchased a new police vehicle approved by the Council; and

WHEREAS, said police vehicle requires equipment and preparations necessary to make it an emergency vehicle for public safety purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have previously passed Resolution 48-17 authorizing the purchase of a police vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the police department has obtained an estimate to transfer equipment from Brekford of Hanover, Maryland that are attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council find it is in the best interest of the Town to engage the services of said vendor pursuant to said estimates as a unique and sole source provider.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Town Council of Town of Forest Heights, Maryland hereby authorizes the Chief of Police to procure the services described in said sales estimates (quote #170551Q) of ~~Major Police Supply~~ General Sales Inc. Laurel, MD, in the amount of ~~\$3,140.00~~ \$3,102.40. Replacing Resolution 53-17 to Resolution 61-17.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect immediately and the Chief of Police is hereby authorized to sign an agreement or other documents to effect rate the intent of this resolution subject to review of any contract terms and conditions by the Town Attorney to be negotiated between the provider.
