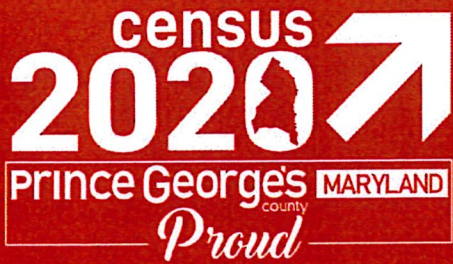

WHAT IS THE U.S. CENSUS?

By law, every 10 years the U.S. Census counts every resident in the United States. Your participation determines representation and how billions in federal funds are distributed. If our community is undercounted, friends and neighbors miss out on an estimated **\$18,250 per person over a 10-year period.** Statewide, that's a total of \$26.6 billion over a 10-year period.



HOW THE U.S. CENSUS IMPACTS OUR COMMUNITY



REPRESENTATION

Determines the number of legislators Maryland has in U.S. House of Representatives.



SERVICES

Funds our roads, schools, SNAP, CHIP, WIC, school lunches, and many other programs.



COMMUNITY FUNDING

If our community is undercounted, we miss out on \$1,825 per person each year.



OUR FUTURE

Informs our planning for transportation, housing, schools, emergency response.



JOBS

Statistics help attract businesses and drive economic development.

EASY

You can complete your census survey by mail, phone, or online.

ACCESSIBLE

You can respond in 12 different languages over the phone or online.

SAFE

Your personal information is confidential, including citizenship and other sensitive data, by law.

CLAIM YOUR RESIDENCY

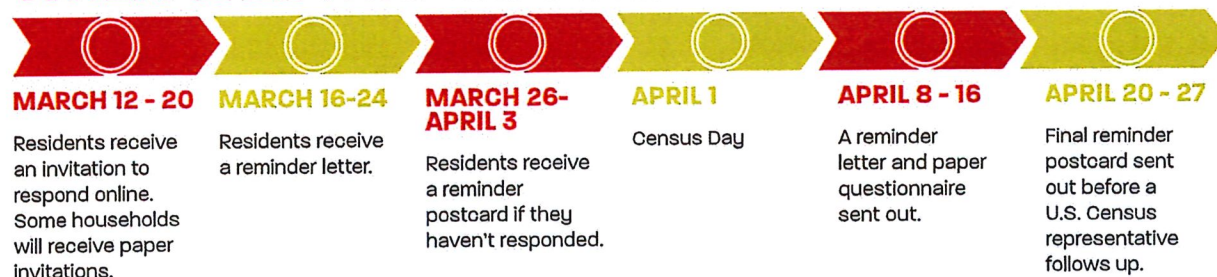

Important Easy and Safe

The United States is required to perform a national count of all people living in each state every ten years (U.S. Constitution, Article 1, Section 2).

The 2020 census impacts Maryland in several important ways.

The census:

- Determines representation in Congress and impacts local legislative districts;
- Is the basis for funding critical programs and services; and
- Assists local decision-making for economic development, school construction and transportation projects, as well as public health, public safety and emergency planning.

Every Marylander Counts!

Get Counted in the 2020 Decennial Census

The Census is Important

Census data is used to determine the level of federal funding for programs such as Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program for Women, Infants and Children (SNAP/WIC), Medicaid, Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) and highway and transportation projects.

- Every year, the federal government allocates more than **\$675 Billion** in funding based on census data.
- Every Marylander not counted costs the state approximately **\$18,250** over 10 years – this equates to the state losing **\$1 Billion** (based on historical U.S. Census undercount).

Completing your census form ensures Maryland families, neighbors and communities receive the support they need to live, work, play and grow.



The Census is Easy

Filling out your census form can be done in three ways – by mail, phone and online.

The 2020 census will be the **first online census** in U.S. history.

Answering the demographic questions in the census helps make sure your community receives its **fair share of funding** and that economic development and planning decisions accurately reflect your community on April 1, 2020.

Some important facts to remember. Don't forget:

- College students should be counted at their college address, either on or off campus. They should be counted at their parents' home only if they live and sleep there.
- All children must be counted including those under five years old.

The Census is Safe

The U.S. Census Bureau must keep all information confidential, including a resident's citizenship, income and other sensitive personal data.

- Data is collected for statistical purposes only and personal data is never disclosed.
- All census information is private and protected by law in Title 13 of the U.S. Code with violations punishable up to five years in federal prison and/or a \$250,000 fine.

So choose the way that you will be counted – by mail, by phone or online.

It is the portrait of us that will last ten years, so let's get everyone in the picture.



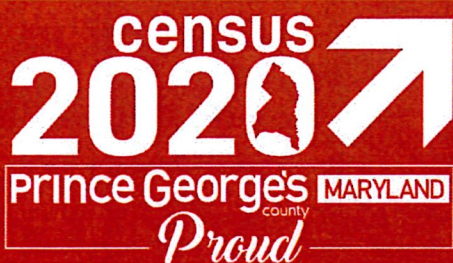

En Los Estados Unidos están requeridos a realizar un recuento nacional de todas las personas que viven en cada estado cada diez años (Constitución de los Estados Unidos, artículo 1, sección 2).

El censo a realizarse en el 2020 impacta al estado de Maryland en varias maneras importantes.
El censo:

- Determina la representación en el Congreso e impacta a los distritos legislativos locales;
- Es la base para el financiamiento de programas y servicios críticos para la Comunidad.
- Asiste a la toma de decisiones locales para el desarrollo económico, la construcción de escuelas y proyectos de transporte, así como la salud pública, la seguridad pública y la planificación de emergencias.

El censo es Importante

Los datos del censo se utilizan para determinar el nivel de financiamiento federal para programas como Medicaid, Medicare, programa de seguro médico para niños (CHIP) y proyectos de autopistas y transporte.

- Cada año, el gobierno federal asigna más de **\$675 mil millones de dólares** en fondos basados en datos del censo.
- Cada Marylander que no se tenga en cuenta en el conteo, le cuesta al estado aproximadamente **\$18,250** en un periodo de 10 años, esto se traduce que el estado estaría perdiendo **\$1 billón de dólares** (basado en datos históricos tomados de la población no contada del U.S. CENSO).

Al Completar su formulario de censo usted garantiza que su familia, las familias de Maryland, sus vecinos y las comunidades reciban el apoyo que necesitan para vivir, trabajar, jugar y crecer.



El Censo es Fácil

Llenar su formulario de censo se puede hacer de tres maneras: **por correo, teléfono y en línea.**

El censo 2020 será el **primer censo en línea** en la historia de Estados Unidos.

Al responder preguntas demográficas en el censo usted ayuda a asegurar que su comunidad reciba su **parte justa de financiamiento** y que las decisiones de desarrollo económico y planificación reflejen con precisión a su comunidad el 1 de abril de 2020.

Algunos datos interesantes:

- Los estudiantes universitarios que viven en el campus deben ser contados bajo la dirección de sus escuelas o deberan ser contados en los hogares de sus padres si ellos residen en la misma y duermen en ella.
- Todos los niños deberan seran contados, incluyendo todos los niños menores a cinco años de edad.

El Censo es Seguro

La oficina del censo de los EE. UU. **debe mantener toda la información confidencial**, incluida la ciudadanía, los ingresos y otros datos personales confidenciales de los residentes.

- Los datos se recopilan únicamente con fines estadísticos y **los datos personales nunca se revelan.**
- Toda la información del censo es privada y está protegida por la ley en el título 13 del código de EE.UU. donde cualquier Violación a la ley podrá ser castigada hasta cinco años en prisión federal y/o una multa de \$250,000.

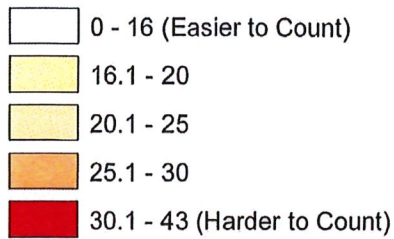


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Hard-to-Count Areas Prince George's County

Predicted Low Response Scores by Census Tract



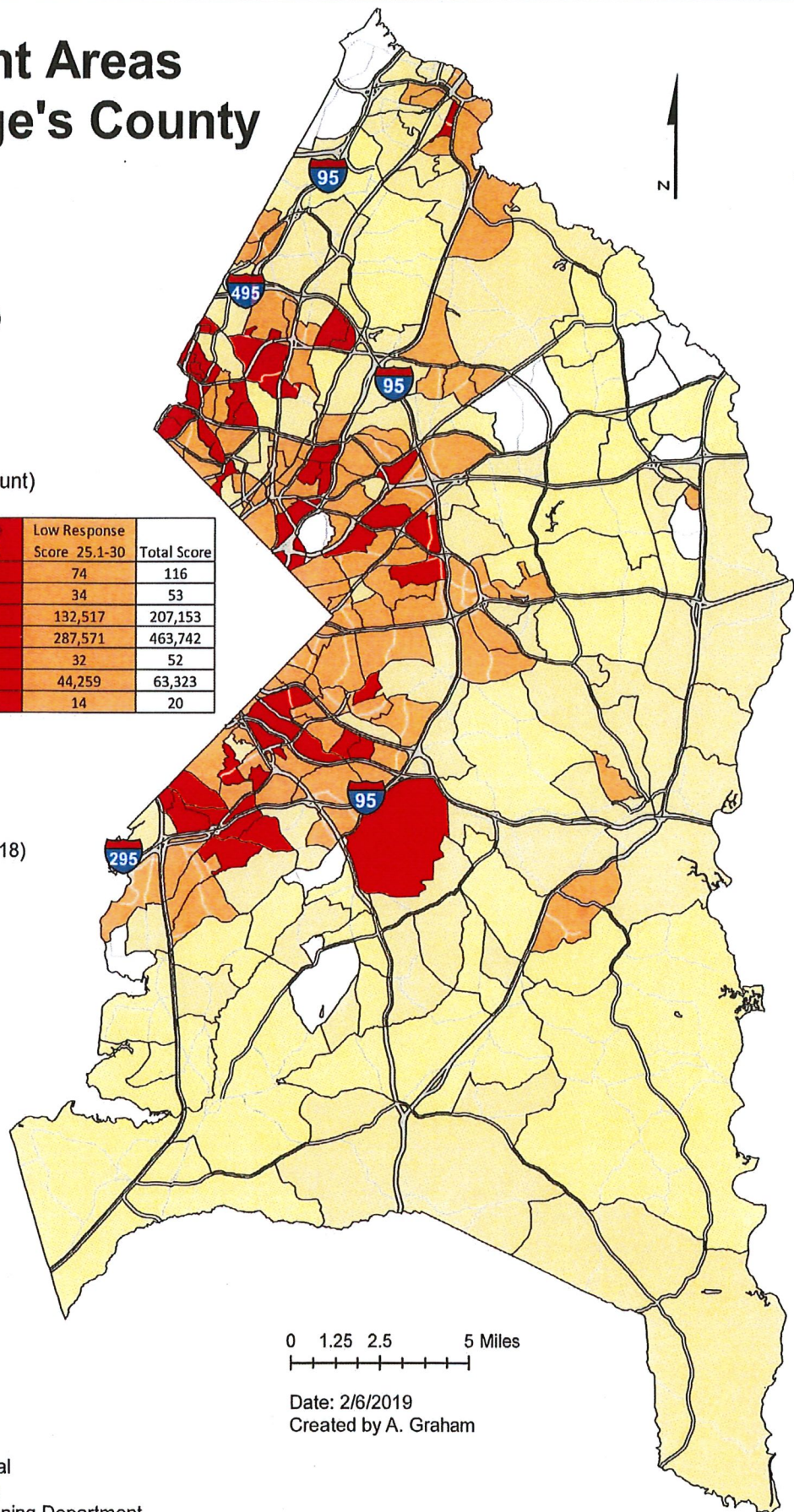

The U.S. Census Bureau is recruiting thousands of people across the country to work on the 2020 Census.

Anyone is invited to apply, including:

- ☐ Retirees.
- ☐ College students.
- ☐ People who do not have a job and are looking for temporary employment.
- ☐ People already working who are looking for a second job.
- ☐ People available to work flexible hours, which can include days, evenings, and/or weekends.

These positions provide an opportunity to earn extra income while helping the community. Pay rates vary depending on the applicant's location.

How to Apply

Interested individuals can apply for a 2020 Census job by visiting 2020census.gov/jobs and completing an online application. The process takes about 30 minutes and will include assessment questions about the applicant's education, work history, and other experiences.

Those who would like to claim veterans' preference will need supporting documentation. For more information, call 1-855-JOB-2020 (1-855-562-2020) and select option 1 for technical assistance or option 3 to speak with someone at your area census office. select option 1 for technical assistance or option 3 to speak with someone at your area census office.

Census takers work in their local communities. Some field positions require employees to work during the day while interviewing the public, so employees must be available to work when people are usually at home, such as in the evening and on weekends.	Census field supervisors conduct fieldwork to support and conduct on-the-job training for census takers and/or to follow up in situations where census takers have confronted issues, such as not gaining entry to restricted areas.://2020census. obs.html national-map.html
Recruiting assistants travel throughout geographic areas to visit with community-based organizations, attend promotional events and conduct other recruiting activities.	Office operations supervisors assist in the management of office functions and day-to-day activities in one or more functional areas, including payroll, personnel, recruiting, field operations, and support.
Clerks perform various administrative and clerical tasks to support functional areas, including payroll, personnel, recruiting, field operations, and support.	
Where are Positions Located? Positions for the 2020 Census are located throughout the United States and Puerto Rico. Visit 2020Census.gov/jobs and explore our interactive map to find Area Office locations and pay rates by county or municipality.	
Who Can Get Hired? To be eligible for a 2020 Census job, applicants must: Be at least 18 years old. Have a valid Social Security number. Pass a Census Bureau-performed background check and review of criminal records, including fingerprinting. For a complete list of qualifications, we invite you to visit 2020census.gov/jobs .	Most jobs require employees to: *Have access to a vehicle and a valid driver's license, unless public transportation is readily available. *Have access to a computer with internet and an email account (to complete training).
