

**RESOLUTION 72-23
THE TOWN OF FOREST HEIGHTS, MARYLAND**

**A RESOLUTION AMENDING PREVIOUSLY APPROVED RESOLUTION 15-23 FOR
THE PROPOSAL AND CONTRACTS REGARDING THE TOWN OF FOREST
HEIGHTS YOUTH BUS FUNDED THROUGH MNCPPC GRANT PROCEEDS**

WHEREAS, the Council approved Resolution 15-23 on January 6th 2023, to approve a proposal and contract with Frontline Mobile Tech and White Dot Services LLC for the Forest Heights Police Department in support of the Town of Forest Heights, MNCPPC-PG, and Prince George's County District 8 Youth and Community Programming.

WHEREAS, the Council found it reasonable and prudent to approve Resolution 15-23 on January 6th,2023, for the purchase of lighting and graphics wrapping for the youth bus and

WHEREAS, due to unforeseen issues with a particular vendor, equipment changes, and other costs outside of the Towns control, staff has recommended modification to the approved resolution and

WHEREAS, the Council previously approved White Dot Services, LLC to perform the graphics work on the bus, and staff found it prudent to utilize another vendor, 97 Acts, Inc. The previously approved amount was \$11,323.35, and the final invoice for 97 Acts, Inc. totals \$15,989.00, here incorporated as Exhibit A and

WHEREAS the Council previously approved Front Line Mobile Tech to perform the vehicle lighting work on the bus, and staff found it prudent to reduce the scope of work on the original quote. The previously approved amount was \$16,184.30, and the final invoice for Front Line Mobile Tech totals \$7,189.00, thereby reducing the sums by \$8,995.30, herein incorporated as Exhibit B and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Town Council of Forest Heights, Maryland, hereby authorize the Mayor or their designee to remit payment through the Finance office to 97 Acts, Inc. and Front-Line Mobile Tech in an amount not to exceed \$15,989.00 to 97 Acts, Inc. and \$7,189.00 to Front Line Mobile Tech to be remitted from the budget line item 8030.1 MNCPPC–Youth.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, this transaction will proceed as further prescribed herein and in the above recitals, which are incorporated by reference herein, and the Mayor or their designee is hereby authorized to execute any acknowledgment and acceptance forms, resolutions, or other documents necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution.
