**A RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT A GRANT FROM THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF
CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT TRAINING**

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police was awarded a grant from The Governor's Office of Crime Control and Prevention under the Bureau of Justice Grant, and

WHEREAS, the Towns Programs Manager applied and was awarded a grant from The Governor's Office of Crime Control and Prevention to help the Police Department to reduce cost of specialized training; and

WHEREAS, with said grant funding, the Chief of Police, according to the approved GOCCP grant funding budget, shall utilize the funding as prescribed: "SUAS Part 107 Programming (Drone Training), and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Forest Heights, Maryland, hereby agrees to authorize and allow the acceptance of a Police Training grant from The Governor's Office of Crime Control and Prevention for the Police Department in the amount of \$5,000 to be use 2/1/2024-6/30/2024.

AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage. PASSED this 4 day of March 2024.


